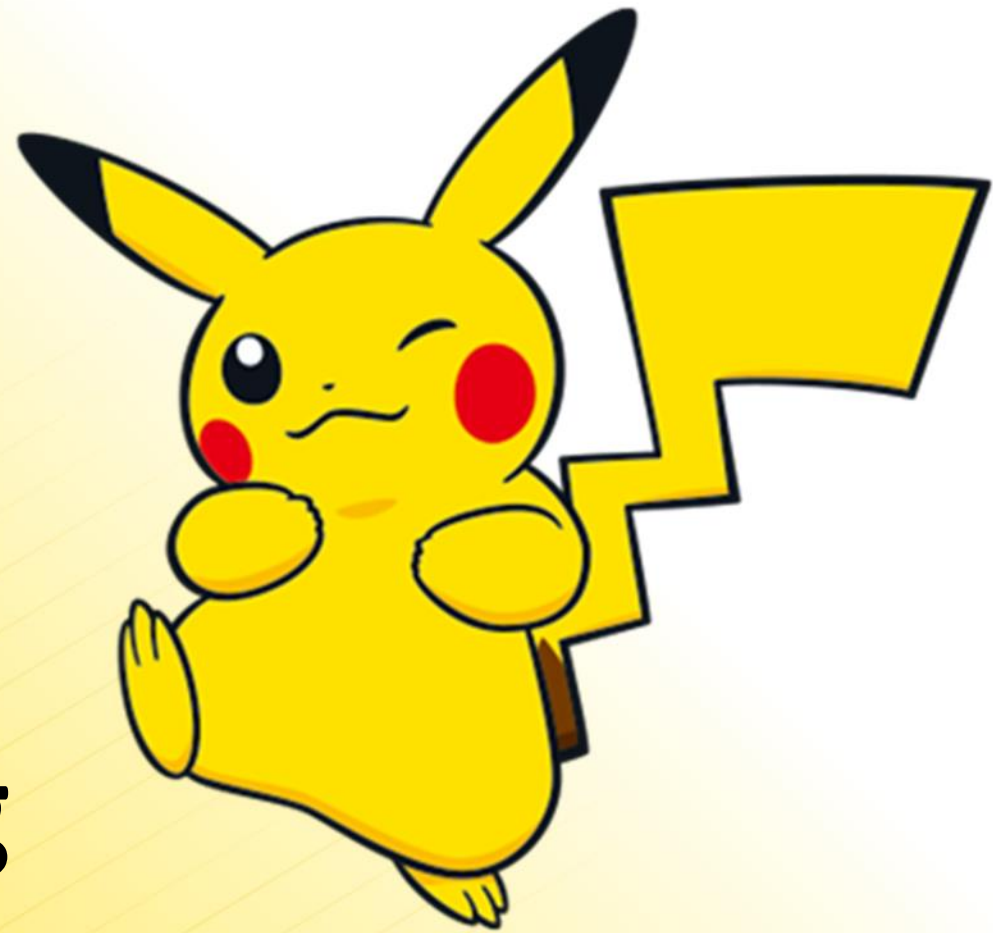

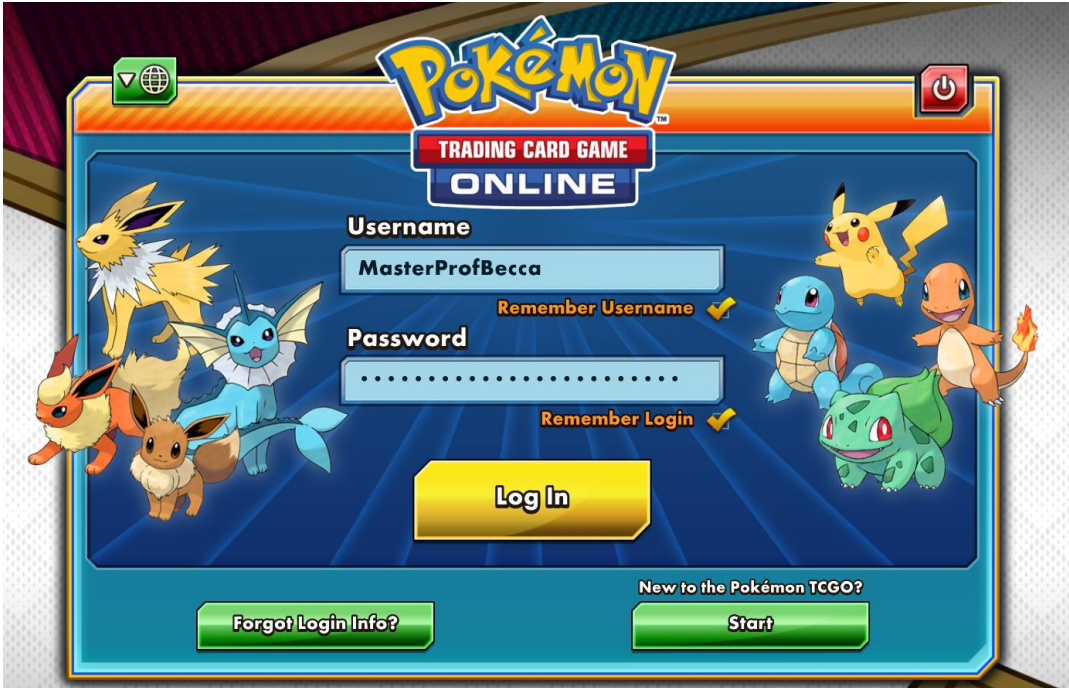

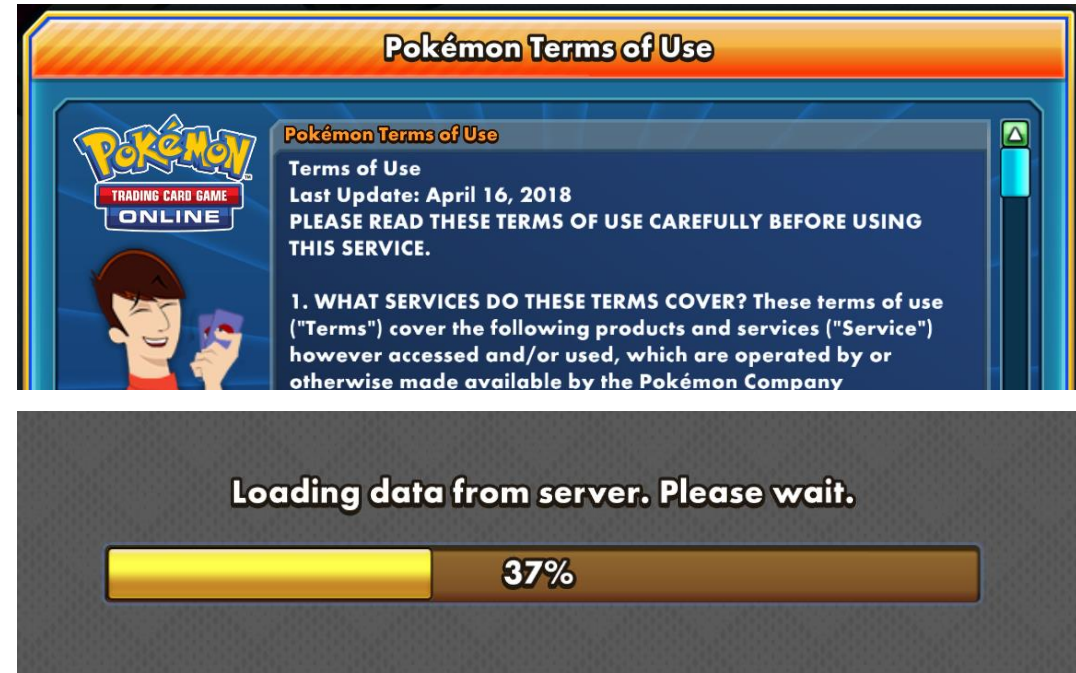

Getting Ready To Play



Step 1

Enter the username and password you use for your Trainer Club Account. Your TCGO account will be created and automatically linked.



Step 2

You will be prompted to accept the Terms of Use. You may also have to wait a short while as data is downloaded. This is normal!

Step 3

Next, you must complete Professor Holly's tutorial. Even if you already know how to play well, it's worth it to grab the rewards for defeating each virtual opponent. Once you see the Trainer Challenge screen, you are ready to begin!

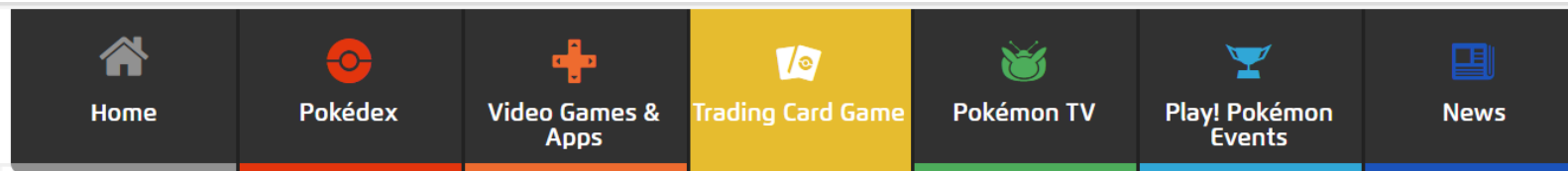


Redeeming Codes

There are two main ways to redeem codes for the TCGO. You can enter them into the **official Pokémon website**, or you can enter them from **inside the TCGO interface**. The choice is yours!

Note: If you are a parent redeeming codes on behalf of your child, make sure that you are logged into the child's account. Otherwise, you may end up crediting your own TCGO account instead.

The Official Pokémon Website

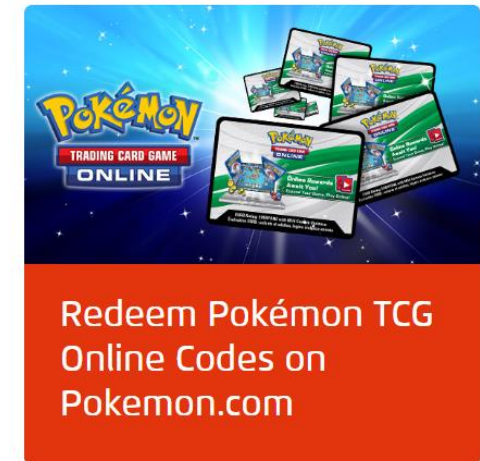


Step 1

From the official Pokémon website homepage, click the 'Trading Card Game' option on the navigation bar.

Step 2

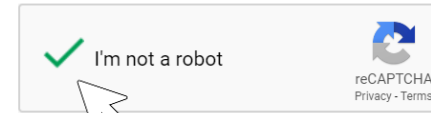
Click on the section entitled 'Redeem Pokémon TCG Online Codes on Pokemon.com'.

Step 3

First things first - complete the CAPTCHA.



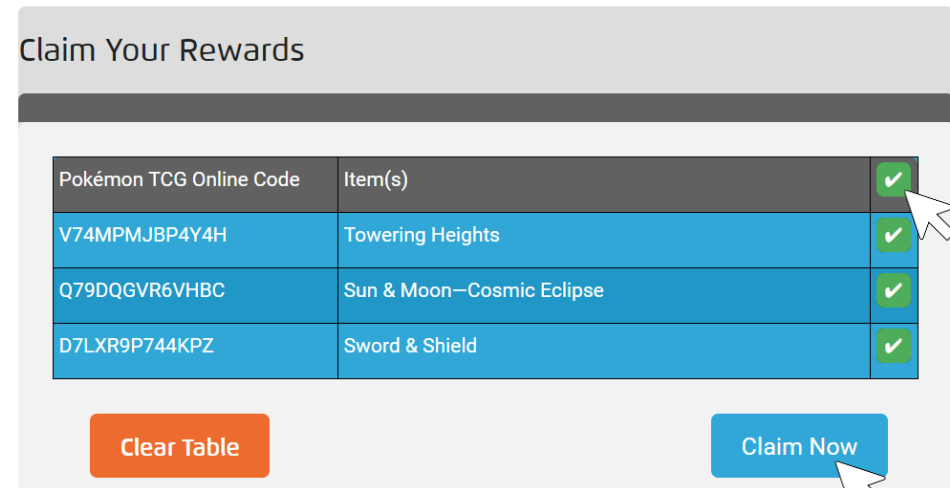
Step 4

Enter the 13-character code on the front of your code card into the text field, and click 'Submit Code'. You will then see the code appear in the table below. You can enter up to 10 codes at a time.



Step 5

Once the table is full, check the boxes next to all the rewards you want to redeem to your TCGO account, and click 'Claim Now'. The confirmation message should appear.

Redeeming Codes | TCGO



Step 1

Click the 'Redeem Codes' button at the top of your screen.

Step 2

You can choose to enter codes by hand into the blue text field, or scan the QR code on the card using the 'Start QR Reader' function.

Step 3

Make sure all the rewards you want to redeem are checked in the 'Claim Your Rewards' section, and click 'Claim Now'. The confirmation message should appear.

Use your computer's webcam to scan QR codes from Pokémon booster packs and theme decks, or manually enter the codes to get Pokémon TCG Online exclusive items!

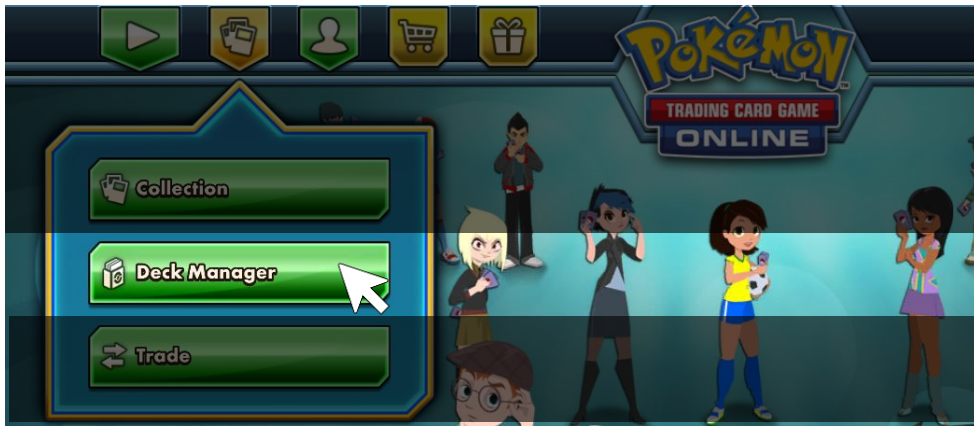

Creating A Deck

Step 1

Click the card symbol at the top of your screen, and select the 'Deck Manager' option.



Step 2

Select 'Create a New Deck'.



Step 3

If you already know the format you will be playing, select the correct format from the list that appears. Otherwise, don't worry about it and just select either Standard or Expanded. You can always edit the deck later!



Step 4

Browse through your collection of cards, and choose which will feature in your new deck.

Step 5

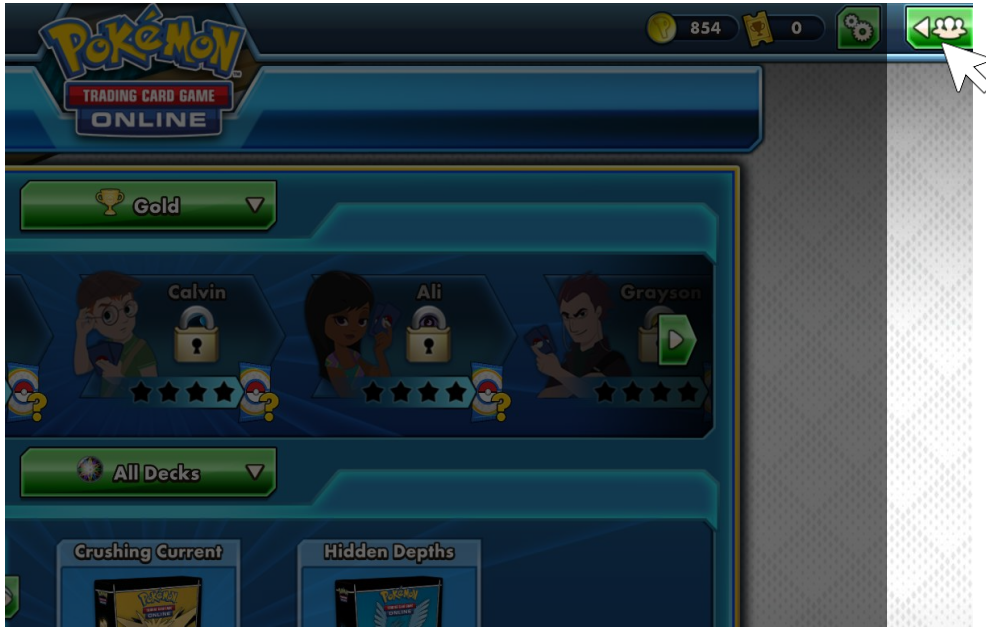
Once you have finished assembling your deck, click the 'Save' icon at the top right of the window. You will now be able to name your deck, and choose a coin, sleeves, and deck box to use with it.

Step 6

When your deck is complete, click 'Save'. You are now ready to play!

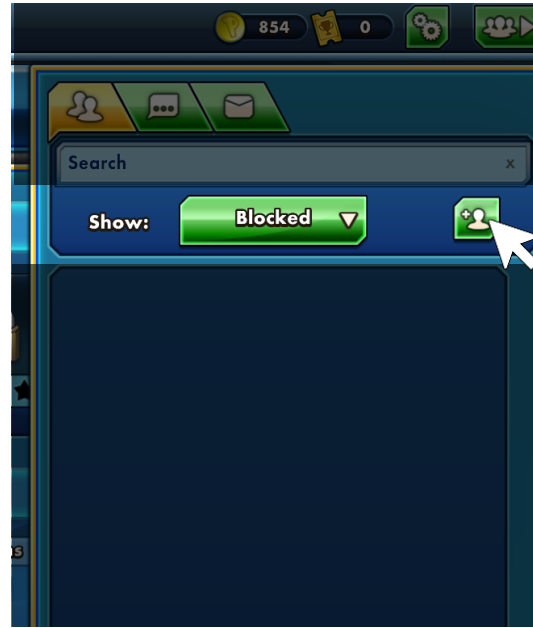


Sending A Friend Request



Step 1

Click the green tab at the top right of the screen to open the menu bar.



Step 2

Click the 'Add Friend' button, and then type your friend's screen name into the text box that appears.

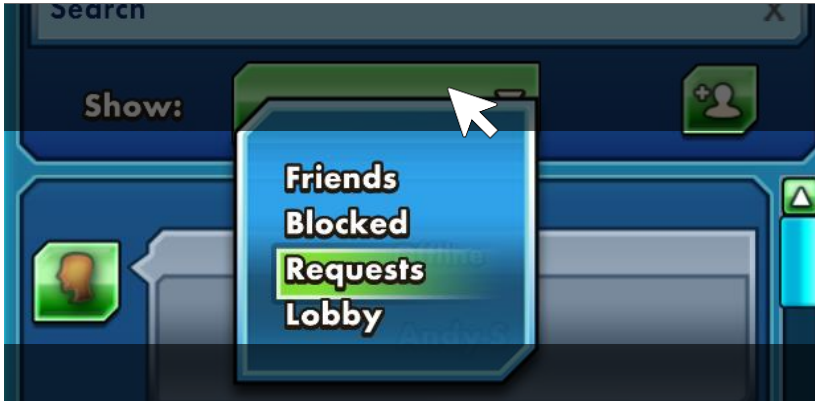


Accepting A Friend Request



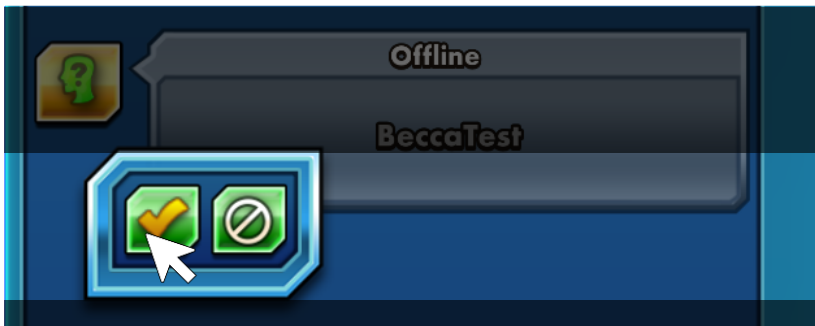
Step 1

When you have received a Friend Request, a yellow notification icon will appear over the green menu tab. Click it to open the menu bar.



Step 2

Select the drop down menu button and click on the 'Requests' option. This will display the screen name of the person who sent the request.



Step 3

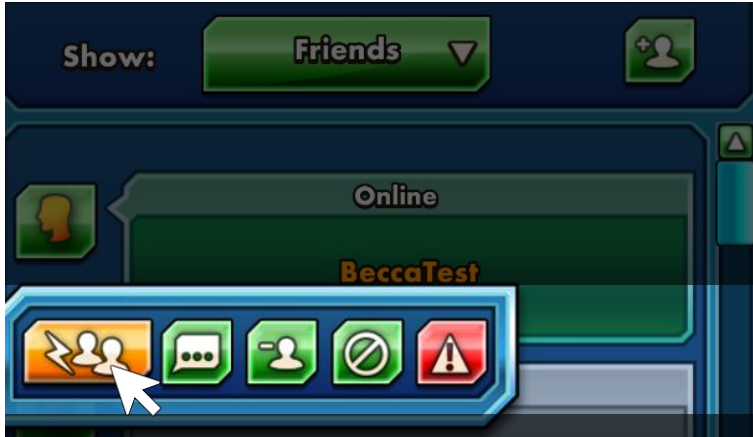
Click on the icon to the left of the name of the person whose request you want to accept, and then click on the checkmark button that appears.



Sending A Challenge To A Friend

Step 1

Click the green tab at the top right of the screen to open the menu bar, and use the drop down menu button to display your list of friends.



Step 2

Click on the icon to the left of the name of the person you want to challenge. Then, select the orange 'Challenge' option.



Step 3

Choose the deck you would like to play with, and then initiate the challenge by clicking 'OK'.

Note: You can only challenge friends who are online!



Accepting A Challenge From A Friend



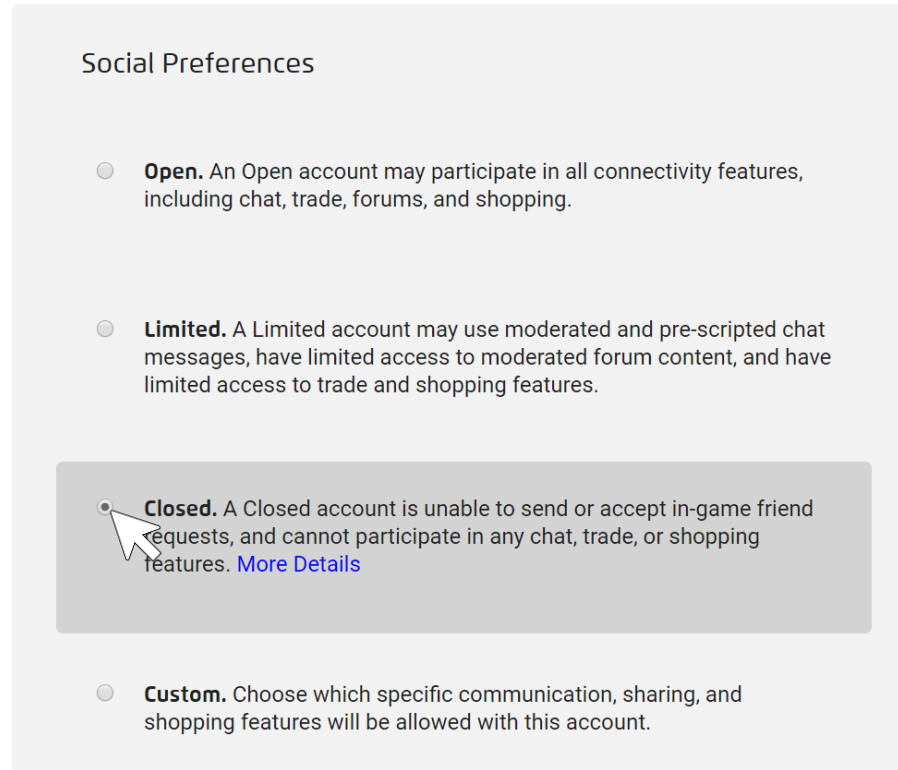
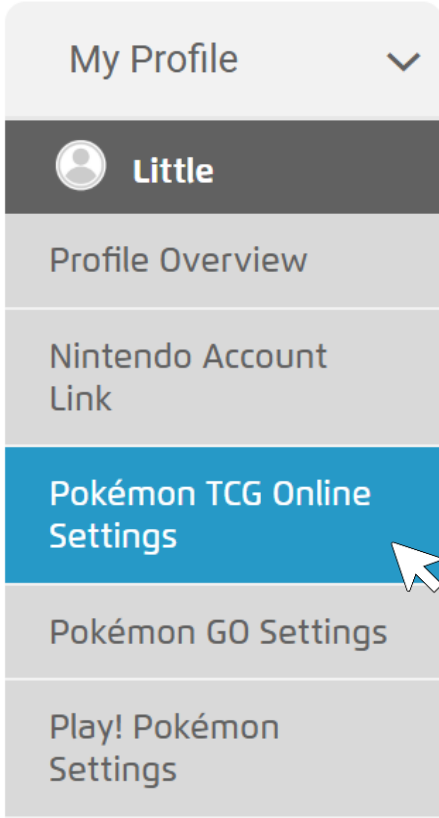
Step 1

When a friend challenges you, a notification will appear on your screen. Choose the deck you would like to play with, and then accept the challenge by clicking 'Accept'. The match will then begin. Good luck!

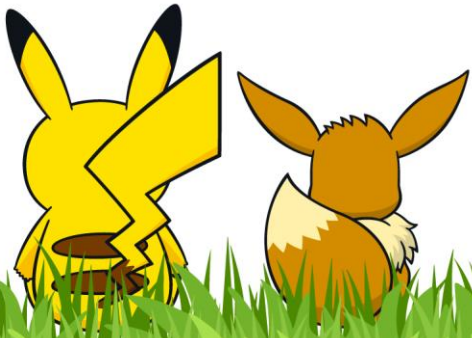


Your Child's TCGO Experience

- You may wish to adjust the settings of your child's TCGO account to limit their ability to participate in some aspects of the game.



- By selecting the 'Pokémon TCG Online Settings' of your child's Trainer Club Account, you can choose the extent to which your child will be able to interact with others.
- Choose from the three pre-set options offered, or select the 'Custom' option to view and adjust each parameter for yourself.
- You can adjust these settings at any time.



Your Child's TCGO Experience

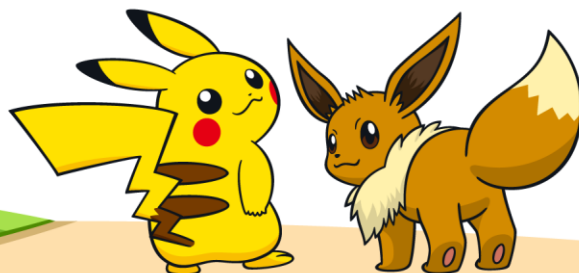
In order to participate in League From Home, the following settings will need to be enabled on your child's TCGO account:

Friend List: **Open**

Your child must be able to accept Friend Requests through TCGO, as Friend Challenges are the primary way in which League players are paired together to play.

Friend Trade: **Open** Public Trade: **Limited**

Players may want to trade cards between each other in order to build decks or to complete certain special tasks. We recommend that your child be allowed to trade openly with League members in their friend list. However, you may wish to limit their ability to trade with those outside the League.



Friend List

- Open: Account may send and accept in-game friend requests freely.
- Closed: Account may not send or accept in-game friend requests.

Friend Chat*

- Limited: Account is able to send and receive pre-approved, in-game phrases and icons to communicate with players on the Friend List.
- Closed: Account is unable to send and receive in-game chat messages with any players.

Friend Trade

- Open: Account may trade freely with players on the Friend List.
- Limited: Account may trade freely with players on the Friend List, but only for cards or objects of similar rarity.
- Closed: Account may not engage in trading.

Game Chat*

- Limited: Account is able to send and receive pre-approved, in-game phrases and icons to communicate with players during a match.
- Closed: Account is unable to send and receive in-game chat messages with any players.

Public Chat*

- Closed: Account is unable to send and receive in-game chat messages with any players.

Private Messaging

- Closed: Account is unable to send or receive in-game private messages. Account is able to send and receive in-game messages from administrators.

Public Trade

- Open: Account may trade freely with players that are not on the Friend List.
- Limited: Account may trade freely with players that are not on the Friend List, but only for cards or objects of similar rarity.
- Closed: Account may not engage in trading with players that are not on the Friend List.

Forums

- Limited: Account can read all areas of the forums but cannot post.
